Women Veteran Strong

As a woman Veteran, you're part of the fastest-growing group within our Veteran population. Of the total population of about 2.03 million women veterans, 755,807 were enrolled in the VA health care system in FY2019. Demand for gender-specific will continue to grow, as the proportion of women veterans to the total veteran population is projected to increase by 0.6% annually through 2045.

A few laws that recognize Women Veterans' rights



Women Veterans Health Program Act of 1992 (Title 1 of P.L. 102-585, as amended), to specifically increase women veterans' access to gender-specific health care services through the VHA.

Title III of the Veterans COMPACT Act of 2020 (P.L. 116-214) required VA to report locations where women veterans use health care, among other things.

Examples of Gender-Specific Health Care Services



General Healthcare and wellness: ex. Primary Health Care Services

Women-specific care for reproductive health:

ex. Maternity Health Care Services/ Newborn Health Care Services

Mental health services:

ex. Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) Services, Military Sexual Trauma (MST) Service

Transitioning to VA Care: Women's Health Transitioning Training (WHTT) Program

- · process of becoming a service-connected veteran,
- differences in the delivery of health care services between VA and DOD medical facilities,
- various types of women's health care services that can be accessed through the VA, and
- available support for other concerns, such as homelessness



Access to Health Care Services

VHA operates more than 1,700 VA medical facilities where veterans can access gender-specific health care services. Veterans can also access these services from contracted providers in their communities and from DOD providers at DOD medical facilities.

(Veterans can access certain gender-specific services such as infertility treatments only from non-VA providers.)
